Philip and Joy Kirkland serve as missionaries in Greece, where they are involved in the launch of a new church plant. One of the ways that they are discipling members is through Bible Studies that meet in different languages. Although their main worship service is in Greek, they understand that the best way to have deep, meaningful learning is in your native language.

English is often the main shared language of people from all over the world. Because of this, the English Bible Study includes a wide range of devoted members from many countries: Cuba, Denmark, Portugal, Czech Republic, Palestine, the United Kingdom and the United States.

They just finished studying 1 Peter, using a simple line-by-line discussion guide. The group meets weekly, sometimes in person and sometimes online as Covid restrictions change.

This small community has grown in size and depth of relationship through regular Bible reading and honest discussion of what God is teaching each of them. Please continue to pray for this young church plant as it shares the hope of the gospel in Athens.

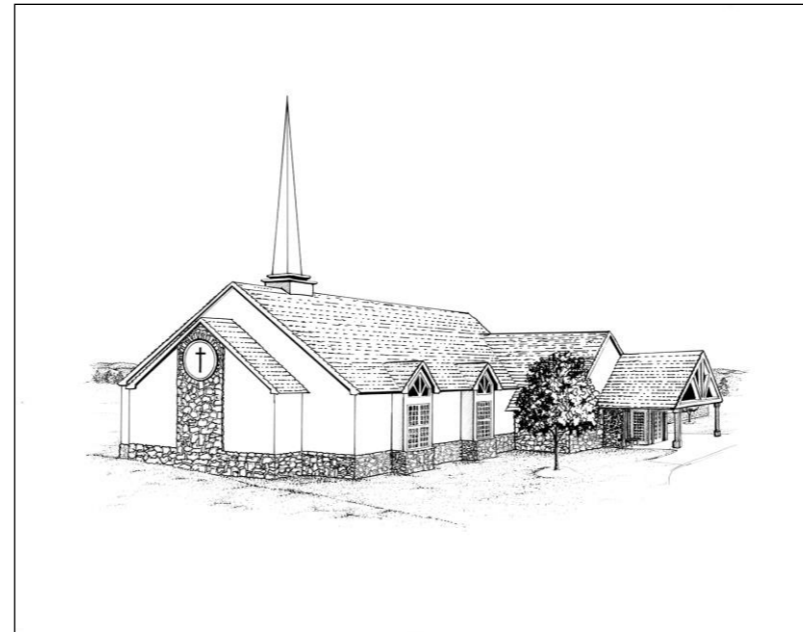
