Missions

Arklie Hooten is the Mission to North America (MNA) Short Term Missions and Disaster Response Director. The Disaster Response Team exists to come to the aide of churches when disaster hits them and their communities. The team recently responded to assist Evergreen Church in Sevierville, Tennessee as they ministered to their neighbors in the Wears Valley who were impacted by wildfires. Churches from Tennessee and Georgia constructed three Sheds of Hope on site in the community.

When a tornado hit Bowling Green, Kentucky back in December, chainsaw teams from Nashville, Tennessee and Louisville, Kentucky were deployed there to assist the local church. Relief funds were also sent to use for many tornado-related mercy needs that surfaced since the storm.

Arklie is praising God for answered prayer in providing a wonderful person to step into the role of MNA Disaster Response Specialist, Carolinas. Steve Jessen has most recently been serving as the senior pastor of First Presbyterian Church in Stanley, North Carolina. He is also a contractor with many years experience, including work with FEMA.

His primary responsibility will be to work with key leaders and churches to increase disaster response structure and capacity within the Carolinas region.


