Missions


Flavien and Inyange serve in sensitive countries where they focus on mentoring missionaries and church planting. Flavien reports that his March trip to Senegal was very fruitful. While there, he met with other men involved with running the Presbyterian church's seminary program and formulated a plan for the future of the church's theological education ministry.

After returning home, Flavien took part in the meeting of the theological education committee of West African Reformed Mission. He found the meeting profitable and was encouraged by representatives from a church in Virginia who want to partner with his work. In addition, Flavien is involved in the meeting of a group of missionaries and theologians called the Southgate Fellowship. The fruit of their work is a document laying down fundamental biblical principles for thinking and doing missions.

Although a little stressful with 7 people in the house, Flavien's family is well and adjusting to life under "stay at home" conditions. They are pleased that Inyange and their daughters' change of immigration status was approved.

Please pray that all these endeavors would glorify God and be used for the edification, growth and multiplication of His Church.
