
Richard and Robyn Crane serve with Mission to the World at Miami International Seminary. When the Cranes proposed teaching the Masters Crisis Counseling course online, their students in Cuba were very excited to be able to continue while they were in quarantine. They are using Norman Wright's book as their main text and added Tim Keller's book, "Walking with God through Pain and Suffering," as well as John Lennox's book, "Where is God in a Coronavirus World." This is the last of 9 courses dealing with counseling in crisis situations such as suicide, death and dying, divorce, domestic violence, and children in crisis. The students have expressed how this course has changed their view on suffering, and that they are grateful to have this training for their ministries.

Due to strict enforcement of protective measures, the pandemic in Cuba is under control. However, their greatest crisis is a shortage of food and basic goods. Many wait in line for hours to get one item at a time, only to find that supplies have run out by their turn. As most pastors only make about \$20 a month, MTW (via the Los Pinos Church leadership) is helping to supplement some of their salaries.
