WHEN YOU BRING YOUR CHILD TO THE NURSERY

It's important to us that you and your child are comfortable and safe while visiting our nursery!

- *Please sign your child in at the appropriate nursery room.
- *You will be given a name tag for your child and a security pick-up tag to present when picking up your child. There will also be an identifying sticker for a diaper bag or sippy cup.
- *Parents are welcome to stay for a bit to help ease their child's transition.

WHAT YOUR CHILD WILL EXPERIENCE

- *Caregivers lovingly play with children throughout the session, striving to meet each child's individual needs.
- *Goldfish crackers are provided as a snack to those age 1 and older. If your child is on a special diet, notify the caregiver and consider supplying an appropriate snack.
- *We plan to check your child's diaper and change it if needed unless you request otherwise.
- *If your child is inconsolable you will be notified promptly.



SAFE AND HEALTHY

- *All nursery caregivers have been thoroughly screened, including criminal background checks.
- *Toys, equipment and rooms are thoroughly cleaned each week to minimize the spread of illness.
- *In consideration of others we ask parents not to use the nursery if your child is not well. Symptoms of sickness include fever, vomiting, diarrhea, cough, runny nose and rash.

NURSING MOTHERS

For your privacy and comfort please feel free to visit room 120 which offers a discreet space to care for your baby. The worship service can be heard in that room.



RESTLESS CHILD OPTIONS

Children are a blessing from the Lord and we are pleased to have them with us during the worship service as part of the church family. We understand that small children are in the process of learning to sit quietly and if your child is becoming loud or persistently restless we thank you in advance for considering those around you by utilizing the narthex (lobby), room 120 (nursery) or room 107 (overflow room) as needed. The service is broadcast to each location.

Activity bags are also available in the narthex for ages 4-5. They contain crayons and paper, puzzles and other activities.

AS YOUR CHILD GROWS

At age 5 children may begin attending Jr. Church. Your child will sit with you in the sanctuary until dismissal prior to the sermon.
